

Consciousness Fields According to Taheri:

Experimental Investigation of the Function and Implication of Consciousness

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The nature of consciousness and its place in the world of science has received much attention in scientific and popular literature in the current century. This has stimulated numerous studies in the form of various projects in diverse specialized fields which have turned the study of this elusive phenomenon into an ever-evolving discipline of mainly metaphysical and subjective nature. There is, however, an emerging new school of thought on Consciousness that is founded entirely on a new and paradigm-shifting definition and function of Consciousness which offers objective, recordable empirical observation with measurable and reproducible results.

This novel approach is introduced by Mohammad Ali Taheri, a contemporary Iranian visionary thinker, scholar, and innovationist who has proposed several revolutionary theories about the nature and mechanism of Consciousness and its implications in human life. He has spent the past forty years analyzing, expanding, and publishing his groundbreaking findings, and leading pioneering research in the area of Consciousness.

Between 2000 and 2009, Taheri founded an educational institution in Iran and began offering intensive courses and seminars on his theoretical concepts and discoveries to the general public and leading academics. He has also authored numerous books and articles delineating his novel theories of Consciousness many of which, including his first book entitled “Human from Another Outlook” (2013), have been translated to English and other languages that have made his concepts accessible to the world. Taheri has recently established the Taheri Academy in Toronto, Canada as the principal education center for the teaching of the Basic Comprehensive Course in his Consciousness theories that offers a specialized curriculum and training program on a global scale. Taheri has been conveying his message of Consciousness to the world by training students who seek instruction and practical knowledge about the Consciousness Fields.

In parallel, Taheri has also founded the institution of *Cosmointel* as the main monitoring center for Consciousness Field studies that are based exclusively on the principles of *SCIENCEFACT*, a new field of science introduced by Taheri that is focused on investigating the application of his theories such as Consciousness Fields (Taheri, 2011), Consciousness Bond of Parts (Taheri, 2011), Consciousness Immunity (Taheri, 2011), in various fields of science including medicine, engineering, and social and biological sciences. *SCIENCEFACT* has laid the groundwork for what Taheri calls “Software Revolution Thinking” where humanity is invited to reexamine its currently one-dimensional quantitative approach to life and consider a perspective that incorporates the

qualitative dimension of Consciousness as an implicit yet integral and pervasive aspect of existence. This new field has strengthened the position of science as an essential tool imperative to the process and emergence of the *SCIENCEFACT* evidence (Taheri, 2013 & Taheri 2020).

Consciousness from Another Perspective

Taheri describes Consciousness as a set of specific fields called Consciousness Fields (CFs) that are of non-material and non-energetic nature, but that have direct effect on the nature of energy and matter. In this theoretical framework, the universe and all its constituents are governed by a rich universal network of data and intelligence known as the Cosmic Consciousness Network (CCN) that contains the entire data and structural and functional information of all animate and inanimate systems (Taheri, 2013). The CFs are the subcategories of the CCN that operate independent of time and space and are capable of implementing structural and functional modifications to the character and behavior of all components of the constituents placed in their field. One such field is the Faradarmani CF to which individuals can connect, via an “Announcer” (certified individuals/authorized members of the R&D Department of Innovative Research Center), in order to receive optimization and update in the form of troubleshooting and repair programs followed by correction and treatment of illnesses and faulty processes, similar to a software update for a computer application. Faradarmani is only one of many types of Consciousness Fields accessible by humans that are distinct and categorized according to their specific function and area of influence (Taheri et al., 2020). Faradarmani and all other applied CFs are mediated by the human mind (“Announcer”) that initiates and establishes connection between the subject of study and the respective CF. In this process, the human mind operates as an interface

capable of connecting to the physical world on the one hand and the Cosmic Consciousness Network on the other.

Since, according to Taheri, Consciousness is a non-quantifiable non-physical factor, it cannot be observed, measured, or explained through physical means or mathematical equations. Therefore, its existence can only be verified indirectly by evidence gained from experiments that document its observable and measurable effect on all physical and biological systems (Taheri, 2013).

The Impact of Consciousness Fields on Biological Systems

It is possible to study the effect of the Consciousness Fields on living organisms at all levels; from biological molecules, cells, tissues, and organs, to the whole living organism. In studies to date, the effectiveness of the Consciousness Fields has been demonstrated on a number of living systems including brain functional activity (Taheri, et al 2020^b), biomimetic structures and nanoparticles, cancer cell lines (Taheri, et al 2020^a), human cancer primary cells, cancer progress in the animal models, salinity resistance in plants (Torabi, et al 2020), animal and cellular models of disease such as Alzheimer's disease. Studies of the effect of Consciousness Fields on the microbial levels have yielded impressive results. On the other hand, the effect of CF on pathogenic bacteria has been associated with reductions in their population as well as their resistance to antibiotics. Changes in the life cycle of different types of bacteria have also been examined, and significant results have been observed in experiments measuring the effect of Consciousness Field on viruses in both laboratory and human environments. In a large study in Iran, during the COVID-19 pandemic, a significant favorable change was observed in reducing mortality and increasing recovery rate following the onset of infection in patients treated with the Faradarmani Consciousness Field. Also, in antiviral laboratory test studies, different types of viruses have

shown changes between two to three logs in populations treated with the Consciousness Fields compared to controls. Publication of multiple full-text articles containing data from these studies in high-impact journals is on the agenda of the Cosmointel Research Center in 2021-2022.

The Goals Ahead

Considering the unprecedented scientific breakthroughs achieved by the successful application of Taheri's Consciousness Fields on biological systems and living organisms, it seems as though the world of science is on the verge of experiencing another crucial turning point in its history.

Taheri's theories have redefined our understanding of the construct of the universe, setting forth the idea that energy and matter are not the only building blocks of the universe and that they are, in fact, a direct result of Consciousness as the third and most fundamental element that gives rise to and governs all forms of energy and matter (Taheri, 2013, 45). *SCIENCEFACT* as a new field of science, introduced by Mohammad Ali Taheri, studies the observable and quantifiable effect of CFs on the nature and behavior of physical and biological systems and, in so doing, bridges the hardware-based, quantitative perspective of the conventional science with the software-based, qualitative perspective of the Consciousness approach.
